HIGH EXPECTATIONS

Parents/Carers expectations of the staff:

- 1. To have highly professional staff.
- 2. To provide information about routines, policies, curriculum and children's progress.
- 3. To be welcomed.
- 4. To be involved in their children's education.
- 5. To know that all staff care for their child.
- 6. To see their child encouraged, challenged and make progress.
- 7. To be able to meet with staff to discuss their child's welfare.
- 8. To be courteous at all times



School's expectations of parents/carers:

- 1. To prepare your child for starting school, i.e. personal care.
- 2. To ensure their child is prepared for the day, i.e. bag, water bottle etc. are in school on the right day.
- 3. To support their child with learning at home.
- 4. To support the code of behaviour and school rules and to talk to all staff with respect.
- 5. To recognise that there are many other children in the school.
- 6. To ensure the child attends regularly and on time.
- 7. To recognise that teaching time is the school priority and to make appointments if the teacher is busy for after school
- 8. To appreciate the commitment and effort the staff give to the school.
- 9. To be courteous at all times and to raise concerns politely. Do not bring children or the school into disrepute via social media, but to raise concerns through the appropriate channels.
