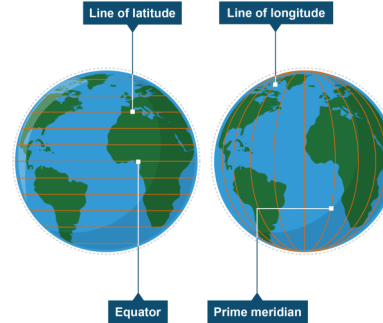




Locational Knowledge

- ◆ Longitude and latitude lines are used to measure how far something is from the Equator and Prime meridian
- ◆ The Prime Meridian is a longitude line that divides the Eastern and Western parts of planet Earth. It runs through Greenwich, London
- ◆ Cities are centre of the biggest trade links for its country



Place Knowledge

- ◆ UK's largest export are cars and gas turbines for aviation
- ◆ Europe export natural and manufactured goods to the UK and wider world; cars, medicines, and crude oil (petroleum)
- ◆ South America provide the UK with fruit and vegetables
- ◆ China, Asia export the largest amount of goods across the whole world
