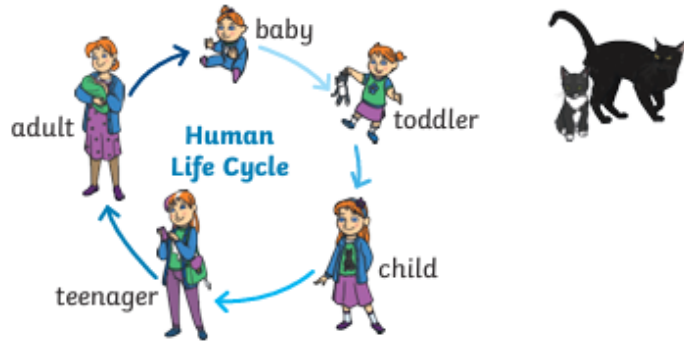




**Core Knowledge**

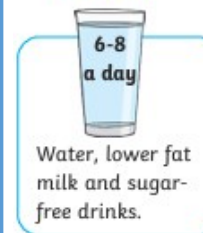
