Invite parent/carers to information events • Set learning at home that reinforces learning at school 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure your child attends school and arrives on time and prepared for the school day • Read the Newsletter so that you are aware of year group news • Look at your child’s year group section on the school website so that you are familiar with current learning expectations. • Support your child in their learning at home or any extra support that is needed • Continue to support and check phonics, spelling, reading, times tables learning at home

<p>To continue to improve communication and engagement with the community</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Involve pupils in the wider life of the school and in our local community so that they develop a love for our local community – Beach and Forest Schools, local events and competitions • Invite parent carers to events to learn about the work of the school ie Curriculum/Subjects • Invite parent/carers into school to help shape and improve it – work parties and events ie tidy ups, environment days, library development groups • Share decision making with the community • Seek parental carer voices • Welcome new families into Homefield • Share good news stories with the community 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support the school’s aims and values • Raise concerns and questions in an appropriate way • Attend school events across both sites • Share good news stories and offer to support the school ie PTA events, volunteer or help whenever able to • Share any talents or special interests with us so that we can establish a bank of good role models and exciting extra-curricular experiences • Understand that decisions at school are taken with the best interests of most children and families, and that sometimes these decisions do not suit all families, all the time.
