<b>Log in to your Emile account to access</b>

<b>Emile Spelling</b>	Select Tasks when logged in. Enter the following code: SY4T1BW2L If you have Bespoke spellings, do not enter the code. Instead, select Spelling – Go To Heim – Select Rating Game
