


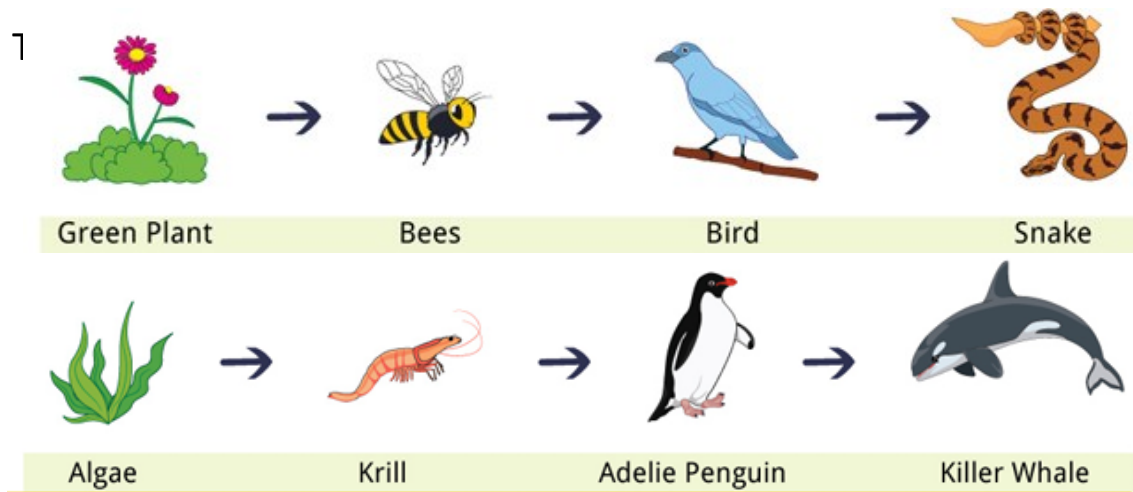




Core Knowledge

<p>living</p> 	<p>Things that are living have all the life processes.</p>
<p>dead</p> 	<p>Things that are dead were once living. They did have all the life processes but don't now.</p>
<p>never living</p> 	<p>Things made out of metal, plastic or rock were never living. They never had the life processes.</p>

All animals depend on plants and other animals for their food.

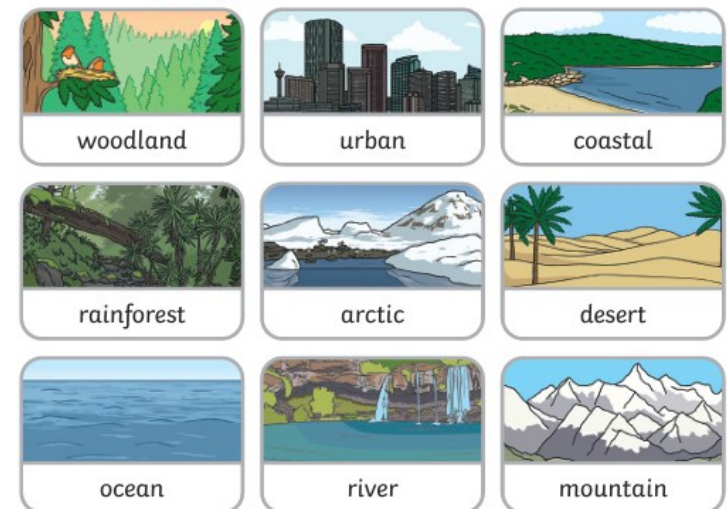


Key Vocabulary

Vocabulary	Definition
habitat	A habitat is the natural environment plants and animals live. A habitat provides living things with everything they need to survive such as food, water and shelter.
micro-habitat	A micro-habitat is a very small habitat, like underneath stones, logs or leaf litter, where a mini-beast might live.
life processes	These are things that all living things do. They move, breathe, sense, grow, make babies, get rid of waste and
