

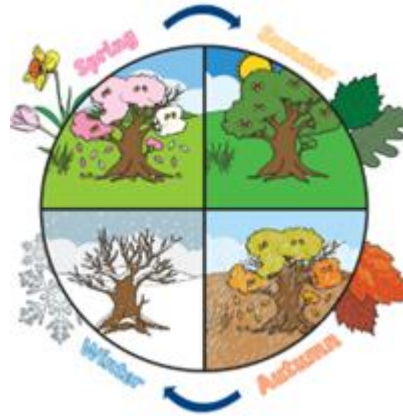


Core Knowledge

In the UK there are 4 seasons each year, spring, summer, autumn and winter. Different seasons have different weather

The Four Seasons

autumn September October November	winter December January February
spring March April May	summer June July August



Remember! It is not safe to look straight at the sun - even wearing sunglasses.

Key Vocabulary

Vocabulary	Definition
weather	The weather includes the temperature outside, how windy it is and how much it rains. We can also describe cloud, snow and sun.
daylight	Daylight is when it is light outside. The amount of daylight changes with each season.
temperature	A measure of how hot or cold something is.

Month	Sept	Oct	Nov	Dec	Jan	Feb	Mar	Apr	May	June	July	Aug
Hours of Daylight	13	11	9	8	8	10	12	14	15	16	16	14
